

- •Use maintenance breaths during RSI
- •Roc is probably better than sux
- •Remove cricoid force during SAD placement
- •Nasal supplementation to oxygenation

Plan A – Facemask Ventilation and Intubation

- •Ramping is in
- •Videolaryngoscopes are in plan A
- •Monitoring of NMB

Plan B – Maintenance of Oxygenation

Use a 2nd generation SAD
Limit insertion attempts to 2

Plan C – Pause and think

Choose between

Front of Neck Access Return to facemask for oxygenation Wake up Continue surgery on SAD Intubate through the SAD
